NAME - *ICCP EDUCATION FOUNDATION (INSTITUTE FOR CERTIFICATION OF COMPUTING PROFESSIONALS)*

DESCRIPTION - *The ICCP provides certification through testing examinations. CCP (CERTIFIED COMPUTING PROFESSIONAL) is the designation awarded upon successful completion of the appropriate certification examinations and required education and work experience. The ICCP is the standard in professional certification for 24 national and international professional computing societies and for numerous individual employers.*

The recognition that comes with the CCP designation makes ICCP the industry's leading professional certification organization.

EDUCATION FOUNDATION FUNCTIONS - *The ICCP Education Foundation is a Board of professional volunteers from industry and academia. The Foundation is an "arm" of the ICCP, however, they work independently to perform research of industry needs in information technology. Such research helps to keep ICCP Examinations up to date and current with the technology and industry.*

The Foundation conducts surveys of educational institutions to determine the type and level of instruction in the computing field provided by various institutions. The purpose of such surveys is to assist educational organizations in meeting the training and education needs of the information technology industry.

The Foundation developed a set of guidelines and procedures which can be used to work with state legislatures and legislators. Such guidelines are designed to provide professional knowledge and assistance in preparing or reviewing potential legislation related to the computing and information technology field.

CBOK is another project which has generated substantial interest with computing societies and educational institutions. CBOK (COMMON BODY OF KNOWLEDGE) researches information which professionals and industry consider important in the information systems field. Such knowledge is identified in numerous specialty categories which technology experts would consider essential in today's rapidly advancing technology in systems development, software development and hardware development and operations as well as management of computing systems and facilities.

OTHER RESEARCH - *in a variety of areas related to our industry is conducted at the request of the ICCP Board of Directors or as needed by our industry.*

OPINION SURVEYS - *are performed, inquiring from Certificate Holders. their opinion of the certification examinations, how they value their certificate and other related questions. Such surveys are conducted every few years with the most recent survey of 35 questions, performed in 1994.*

EDUCATION FOUNDATION FUNDING - is not provided by the ICCP. Therefore, as a separate arm of the ICCP, we must rely on grants, donations and financial support from individual computing societies, individuals who have earned their CCP Certification and other organizations or companies.

The ICCP Education Foundation is a 501 (c) (3) non-profit organization incorporated separately from the ICCP itself. Any financial or other resource support for the Foundation may be considered as a tax deductible expense.
